André Maurois was an active French author of novels, biographies and critical essays. This collection consists of extremely valuable literature, originally in André Maurois' possession and dedicated from his contemporaries.

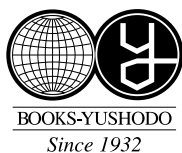
André Maurois' literary activities encompassed fiction, history, critical essays and biographies; all of them attracted many readers. He experienced immigration to England and the United States during the World War II, which eventually widened his scope of experience beyond his homeland of France. Many books were dedicated to him from notable people from many countries and a wide-range of specialties.

The core of this collection was brought in from as many as 325 people. Each book has an inscription or an autograph, some from famous authors or publishers. The collection contains limited editions, some with Maurois' autograph, as well as his letters, name cards, and lecture notes.

Another important feature of this collection is that approximately 100 books include memos and entries in Maurois' handwriting. Ex-libris literature helps to provide invaluable evidence about his thinking and life.

The books in this collection bring up various topics such as; literary theory, reading materials, poetry, drama, memoirs, biographies, mystery, film, fine arts, history, religion, philosophy, archaeology, politics, education and natural science, and sociology.
